What is the Employee Assistance Program?

The Employee Assistance Program is a benefit offered by your employer and Family Service, Inc. to provide confidential help for you. The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) provides a confidential resource outside the workplace that assists you and in some instances, your immediate family members with personal problems before job performance is affected.

Why an Employee Assistance Program?

Personal problems are part of everyone's life. Some of these problems become too big to be solved alone and can interfere with job performance. Asking for help can be the first step toward resolving a problem and a positive way to overcome a negative situation. Job security or promotional opportunities are NOT jeopardized by seeking counseling.

Is it confidential?

Absolutely! Any contact with Family Services, Inc. is confidential. The information is NOT reflected in any personnel record.

Who can use the EAP?

All employees are eligible to utilize the Employee Assistance Program. In some instances legal dependents may also be covered under the benefit!

What types of problems are addressed?

- Marital/relationship concerns

- Personal/emotional concerns
- Alcohol/drug problems
- Stress
- Work concerns and related problems
- Traumas
- Elder care

What does EAP cost?

The initial counseling sessions are paid for by your employer. Fees for continued counseling or treatment may be covered by insurance. Family Service, Inc.'s business office can help you determine this.
